

Directions for Using *Turn It In.com*

Composition students are required to use Turn It In to check for inadvertent plagiarism in their essays BEFORE submitting or posting them for instructor reading and assessment. Generate a "similarity" report, examine the results, and then revise so that your essay has no more than 5% similarity. After revising your essay, resubmit it for a final similarity check. **I will not read your essay until these steps have been completed.**

1. Use Chrome and go to:

<http://turnitin.com/>

2. CREATE AN ACCOUNT (top right-hand corner):

- Type your school email address.
- create a personal password: first initial, last initial +school ID (ex: sm300447)
- Enroll in your class, using the class code # and class password (see below)

Directions: Click on the assignment and submit your essay to check for similarities to published sources. Wait a few minutes, and you should be able to view your originality report. **Check and revise any plagiarism issues, making sure all sources are given attribution, all wording is original to you or is within quotation marks.** Revise and resubmit until your originality report is clear (no more than 5% to account for common phrasing). You can resubmit your essay until the assignment due date, although it may take up to 24 hours to produce another report. Ignore "similarity" of your name and facts of common knowledge (e.g., The Vietnam war was unpopular.)
